I read online that when a baby has croup you need to take them outside in the cool air or run the shower, let the room fill with steam and sit in the room with the child. The cool, moist air helps soothe the breathing passages. Croup is caused by swollen and irritate air passages and it makes it very painful and difficult for the child to breathe which is what causes the deep, barking sound.

Miranda also had a fever of 103/5. Cliff gave her some Tylenol and had her rest on his shoulder all night to help her breathe easier. He let me get some sleep. What a great husband I have!! xoxoxo
